PROFESSOR JOHNSEN IS AN EXPERT IN COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF LEGAL SERVICES POLICY IN EUROPE. HE HAS ALSO COMPLETED RESEARCH ON CULTURAL BARRIERS TO THE SÁMI PEOPLE’S (THE INDIGENOUS PEOPLES OF NORTHERN EUROPE INHABITING THE SÁPMI) USAGE OF THE LEGAL SYSTEM IN NORWAY.

HE HAS WORKED WITH THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE’S “COMMISSION FOR THE EFFICIENCY OF JUSTICE” (CEPEJ) ON A MAJOR COMPARATIVE RESEARCH PROJECT, AND IS CURRENTLY WORKING ON DELAYS IN EUROPEAN JUDICIAL SYSTEMS FOR THE CEPEJ.

PROFESSOR JOHNSEN WILL BE IN RESIDENCE AT FLINDERS UNIVERSITY BETWEEN 23 OCTOBER 2008 AND 20 JANUARY 2009 AS AN IUEU CENTRE DISTINGUISHED RESEARCH FELLOW.
